PRIORITY		DESCRIPTION
1	MONDAY OCT 15	Students who have completed the matriculation* process, meet the eligibility criteria and are participating in the following programs: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EOPS • SAS (DSPS) • CalWORKs • TANF/Tribal TANF • A veteran • An active member of the military Or the following – ok up to dismissal: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Foster Youth • Homeless Youth
2	WEDNESDAY OCT 17	New students who have completed the Matriculation* process and are not one of the identified groups in Priority 1 Student athletes (matriculated and in good standing)
3	FRIDAY OCT 19	Continuing COM students (in good standing) who have completed the matriculation* process and have a current Ed Plan***
4	MONDAY OCT 29	Continuing students (in good standing) with 30 – 74.5 completed and in-progress units.**
5	WEDNESDAY OCT 31	Continuing students (in good standing) with 1 – 29.5 completed and in-progress units.**
6	FRIDAY NOV 2	Continuing students (in good standing) with 75 – 99.5 completed and in-progress units.**
7	MONDAY NOV 5	Concurrently enrolled high school students
8	WEDNESDAY NOV 7	All other categories, including (but not limited to): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New applicants who have applied for admission but not completed the matriculation* process • Returning students • Readmitted students after dismissal • Students with 100+ completed degree-applicable units at COM • Students who are not in good standing (on academic or progress probation or dismissal)

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Your enrollment priority will be determined by your status as a new, continuing or returning student at College of Marin, and a series of steps called matriculation that are designed to help you be successful as a college student. By completing each of these steps you will earn the right to register early in the registration cycle, providing you with the best chance of securing the classes you need each semester.

* **Matriculation:** Orientation, English and math Placement via HS records or Assessment, Counseling/Student Educational Plans (SEP)

** **Upgrade priority opportunity:** Continuing COM students in good standing who have completed the Matriculation* process before the priority determination date for the next registration cycle will be upgraded to Priority 3.

*** **Current Ed Plan:** A provisional or long term Ed Plan for the upcoming semester(s) that a counselor certifies for the student for each semester. If the student fails to update their Ed plan with a counselor as indicated they will fall back to lower priority.

(For Fall 2019: The SEP will be considered “current” as long as Fall 2019 is included, whether the student came in to see the Counselor once, or more times.)
